"At Nando's, a sustainable and ethical supply chain is integral to what we do and stand for as a business. We are fully committed to playing our part in ensuring high standards are constantly met, and work closely with all our suppliers who, like us, take their responsibilities for soy sourcing very seriously. Since the Bureau of Investigative Journalism report, we have joined the industry in signing the UK Soy Manifesto and are working hard to implement this."

What actions relating to the monitoring of supply chains linked to Cargill has your company taken, or is taking, following the TBIJ exposé?

"We are constantly in close contact with all our suppliers to ensure certain commitments and standards are met throughout our supply chain. Robust protocols are followed by all our suppliers with regards to investigating any allegations that the production of soy does not meet required standards."

- By way of clarity and for awareness, it would be incorrect to say that Nando's has a direct link to Cargill.
- Nando's is supplied in the UK by a company that is a customer of Cargill.
- This supplier is an independent UK business.
